Head south from Calgary through the rangelands of Cowboy Country to where the plains meet the foothills. Your destination today is Head Smashed in Buffalo Jump, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that tells the story of the hunting practice of the native people of the North American plains for the past 6000 years. A Blackfoot Interpreter leads you through the exhibit and out to the cliff jump, sharing the history and lifestyle of the first people. Also included in your visit today is a blessing & smudging ceremony, a storytelling session with and and a Buffalo themed lunch on site. Take part in the hands-on, interactive “Living off the Land” program that goes into detail of the different uses of the buffalo. You will have plenty of photo opportunities plus time to check out the gift shop before returning to Calgary later today.
